

**Cefor Condition Survey Clause**

For use with covers on other insurance conditions than those of the Nordic Marine Insurance Plan of 2013.

It is agreed that a condition survey of the insured vessel shall be held within a time limit stipulated by the Insurer at the Assured's expense, by a surveyor appointed or approved by Insurer.

If the survey is completed prior to the attachment of the insurance, the Insurer has the option to withdraw his offer of insurance or follow the procedure described below, which shall also apply to condition surveys held after the attachment of the insurance.

Upon receipt of the survey report the Insurer may:

- (a) approve the vessel without reservation,  
or
- (b) require corrections or repairs of significant deficiencies or defects within a written and agreed time limit after which the defects or deficiencies will be resurveyed on behalf of the Insurer at the Assured's cost,  
or  
amend the terms and conditions of the insurance,  
or  
exclude liability for loss caused by specified defects or deficiencies,  
or  
cancel the insurance by giving 14 days notice if the vessel is unseaworthy or if the Assured refuses to implement the Insurer's requirements.

It is understood and agreed that the survey referred to above in no way prejudices the Insurer's right to avoid or limit liability under the terms of the insurance contract or applicable law, and that the said survey does not imply any acceptance by the Insurer of the vessel's seaworthiness or of liability for any fault or deficiency in the vessel, whether detected by the survey or not.

It is emphasized that notwithstanding the survey the sole and entire responsibility to keep the vessel in a seaworthy condition remains on the Assured, including compliance with safety regulations and all the rules and recommendations of the vessel's classification society.
